

Assembly Instructions

The Barrowden set

Before you commence the assembly process we recommend that you read these instructions thoroughly beforehand to familiarise yourself with the assembly process and to also check that you have the correct components. If for any reason you need assistance, you can find our contact details on the final page of these instructions.

We highly recommend that any assembly is carried out on a flat, level surface if possible and that you use another person to assist you if necessary.

Please note: Whilst a single width seat is shown here, the assembly process is identical for all Barrowden seat models. When checking your components, only the companion and combo seats will contain the table section element. Also, the components listed are per seat so these will be doubled or tripled in quantity depending on the model you have purchased. The assembly process shown here is for our Barrowden dining table. However, the same process applies to *all* of our Barrowden table models.

Tools required: 1

13mm and 10mm socket or spanner, Hammer

M8 Nut, bolt and washers	1 x M8 120mm coachscrew	1 x Seat back panel	1 x Seat panel	1 x Right arm frame

Step 1



Attach the Left arm frame to the Seat panel as shown using 4 of the M8 bolts. If required, use a hammer to drive the bolts fully home...

Step 2

...and secure in place with 4 of the washers and nuts as shown. Do not fully tightens the nuts at this stage.

Step 3



Affix the Right arm frame to the other side of the Seat panel in the same way.



Position the Seat back panel as shown and fix into place using the remaining fixings, again using a hammer if neccessary. Now fully tighten *all* of the nuts and bolts. The Barrowden seat is now complete. For companion seats, please consult step 5 onwards.

Step 5



For a double or triple seat attach the centre strut of the Seat panel to the Seat back panel using the M8 120mm coachscrew .

Step 6



For an angled companion seat place 2 Barrowden seats as shown - at an angle of around 60° to each other. Now lower the table section into place. Adjust the position of the seats so that the seat edges are aligned with the table section outer frame.



For a straight companion seat place 2 seats parallel to each other and 21cm apart. Now lower the table section into place.



If necessary slide the table section backwards until it stops.

Step 9



Place the table top upside down as shown and take one leg so that the holes in the leg are aligned with those in the table top.



Now push 2 of the M8 bolts into the holes, using the hammer if necessary to drive the bolts fully into place.



Place an M8 washer and nut onto each bolt and fully tighten.

Repeat adding legs in the same fashion until all 4 are attached securely. Your Barrowden set is now complete.
