

# Assembly Instructions

# The Double Premium Pergola & Decking Kit

Before you commence the assembly process we recommend that you read these instructions thoroughly beforehand to familiarise yourself with the assembly process and to also check that you have the correct components. If for any reason you need assistance, you can find our contact details on the final page of these instructions.

We highly recommend that any assembly is carried out on an open flat, level surface if possible with sufficient space. You will also require the assistance of at least 2 adults to complete assembly safely.


Please note: For a free-standing pergola you can remove up to 400mm from the bottom of each post prior to commencing construction.





# **Component List**

Tools required:		10mm socket, No2 Pozidriv screwdriver (or electric driver), step ladder or platform.

If you have ordered your pergola with a roof slope please refer to the charts below for guidance of the difference in length that you will need to cut your posts to accommodate the slope.



#### Step 1




Select an area for your decking that is stable, firm and level. Layout the 2 x Base frame assemblies and 2 x Edge joists in a rectangle and then place the remaining infill joists roughly in place as shown here.

#### Step 2




Attach the edge joists to the base frame assemblies using  $2 \times 75$ mm screws in the pre-drilled holes, making sure that the ends are flush and everything is square. Repeat for all 4 corners.

#### Step 3



Line up the ends of each infill joist end with the markings on the edge joists, making sure the top faces are also flush, before screwing each end into place with 2 x 75mm green screws. Add the remaining joists to complete the frame for the decking.


#### Step 4



Get an assistant to hold the first post in place, housing it in the pocket formed where the base frame assembly and edge pieces meet.



# Step 5




Secure the post in place with a 70mm coach screw through the Base frame assembly into the post as shown here.

### Step 6




Attach the remainder of the posts so you now have one in each corner.

# Step 7



Have an assistant (or even two) help you lift one of the runner (note the multiple notches) so that the face with the countersinks is outer most, the top is level with the posts and the notches align either side of the post...

# Step 8




...before securing each end into place with 2 x 70mm coachscrews.

# Step 10




Attach a second runner to the other side of the posts from the first runner as you did in Steps 7-8. Then add the remaining runners to the final 2 posts.



Drop the pre-drilled outer rafters into the slots on either side of the posts as shown above.




Secure each one in place with a 120mm coachscrew driven down into the runner at each end.




Now drop the plain rafters into the remaining slots...

# Step 13




... securing them as before with a pair of 120mm coachscrews.

# Step 14




Slide a brace up between the rafters/runners so that one end is flat against the post and the other is flush with the top edge of the rafter/runners.

# Step 15




Fix the bottom end in place with 2 x 70mm coachscrews into the post..

# Step 16




...and the top end with two x 75mm screws as shown.

#### Step 17




Repeat Steps 14-16 and add the remaining braces.

#### Step 18




Place one of the Post deck slats so that it runs post to post, perpendicular to the deck frame joists. Make sure the edge is flush with the outer edge of the frame before securing each end in place with  $2 \times 65 \text{mm}$  screws.

#### Step 19




Find the most central joist and, having checked the edge of the deck slat is flush with the frame edge (push/pull the slat into place if required) secure in place with 2 x 65mm screws into the joist. Attach the second Post deck slat to the opposite side of the base in the same way.

#### Step 20




Now arrange the upstand edge decking pieces around the perimeter of the base (note how the longer pieces run parallel to the Post deck slats from the previous Step). Fix the end of each piece into place at each post with 2 x 65mm screws as shown here.

#### Step 21




Lay one of the deck slats across the base, perpendicular to the joists. Make sure this slat sitting on the base framework correctly and use this as a guide to ensure the centre of the upstand piece is flush with deck. Push/pull the upstand up or down if necessary before fixing it into place with 2 x 65mm coachscrews.

#### Step 22




Half way between the post and the frame centre add further intermediate screws to finish securing the upstand edge slats in place. Attach the remaining upstand edge slats using the procedures in Steps 20-22 (rotate the deck piece across the base through 90° as necessary).

#### Step 23




Lay out all of the decking pieces across the infill joists and adjust until you have them evenly spaced across the base.

# Step 24




Fix both ends of every slat down with 2 x 65mm screws.

#### Step 25




Locate the each of the infill joists by looking through the gaps in between the slats and secure every decking slat to each infill joist with a pair of 65mm screws.

# Step 26



Attach four cladding panels to each post by aligning with the post, bevelled face uppermost, and secure in place with  $4 \times 65 \text{mm}$  screws.

#### Step 27



Your Double Premium Pergola and Decking Kit is now complete.
